Here are some questions from the mailbox:

Does the 72 hour rule include unit meetings?

For those who may not be familiar with this reference, the **Guide to Safe Scouting** states:

All adults accompanying a Scouting unit who are present at the activity for 72 total hours or more must be registered as leaders. The 72 hours need not be consecutive.

This rule applies to long term camps. The fact that the hours need not be consecutive doesn't mean that hours are cumulative. In other words, the rule doesn't apply to weekly unit meetings. Thank goodness!

I seem to have multiple member numbers, so my training isn't showing up. How do I fix that?

You can merge member numbers by doing the following:

- I. In My. Scouting, go to Legacy Tools -- Manage Member ID
- 2. You should see two ID's listed. Change the Primary ID and save.
- 3. Wait 24 hours, and then set the other ID to primary and wait 24 hours.
