Kevin had been active in Scouting since the 1970s, and mentored countless young men over the years, including 52 Eagles. Please keep his family in your thoughts and prayers. He will be sorely missed.

<u>ALL JANUARY IN-PERSON DISTRICT SCOUTING ACTIVITIES AT CABRILLO ARE POSTPONED</u> This includes Pinewood Derby Ready to Race, IOLS, and Merit Badge Day Camp. See the <u>Pacifica Calendar</u> for updates.

REOPENING PROTOCOLS UNITS MAY NOT MEET IN PERSON UNDER VOLUNTEER SUPERVISION. This prohibition includes meetings of adults and any meeting in the outdoors. The County's recent surge response update has temporarily suspended the *one* exception provided by County Health orders for youth sports activities.

<u>UNIT USE OF CABRILLO</u> Reservations are now available for sites at Cabrillo (as well as other Council properties) as early as February, assuming County Health Orders will permit us to open the facility to units. You will need to do two things prior to making a reservation:

- 1) <u>Establish a UNIT Tentaroo account</u>, if you don't already have one. *This is different from any personal accounts* your Scouters may have! If you are having trouble accessing your unit account, email <u>Kevin.Burton@scouting.org</u> to re-set your credentials.
- 2) Complete Council's <u>Online Booking Request form</u>. Please note that it may take 3-5 business days in order to approve your first booking.
