MERIT BADGE/NOVA AWARD COUNSELORS There is a NEW submission process for applications to become a new counselor for merit badges or STEM Nova awards, or for existing counselors modifying their status. Going forward, please submit all applications and supporting documentation via this Google form: https://forms.gle/WmEvLvfi6cq6C9DH8

The new form includes a checklist of all the documentation required to successfully complete an application. A Google account is required to upload your application forms. If you do not have a Google account, or need help obtaining supporting documents, please contact your unit's Merit Badge Counselor Coordinator or Advancement Chair for assistance. Members ("Arrowmen") provide service their home Units, the Pacifica District, our Council, and BSA nationally. OA provides Youth members additional service and leadership opportunities that help them grow and build experience. Members are sent virtual Meeting invitations via the LodgeMaster application.
