<u>NEW ROUNDTABLE COMMISSIONER WANTED</u> After serving for the past three years as Roundtable Commissioner for Pacifica, I'm feeling that it's time to pass the torch and direct my focus on other priorities. If anyone would be interested in taking over as Roundtable Commissioner or feels they know of someone who would be a good fit, please let Nancy or myself know.

<u>PLEASE TAKE AB506 TRAINING BEFORE FEB 28</u> California Law AB506 requires youth serving organizations to take certain steps to protect children. See GLAAC announcement <u>HERE</u>. BSA Councils across the state are collaborating to support this effort, and have created <u>this website</u>, including a very useful <u>FAQ</u>. Here are some tips for success:

- 1) Create an account, using the email where you want to receive your certificate
- 2) Check spam folder for account verification email
- 3) You'll be offered multiple versions of the course (e.g. "General Training," "School Personnel," "Medical Professionals," etc. ) Select "Volunteers"
- 4) Volunteers aren't mandated reporters by state rules, but Scouters ARE mandated reporters per BSA policies
- 5) You will NOT be required to take an exam—the course will automatically skip it
- 6) Once your certificate is emailed to you (again, check spam) please <u>upload</u> it
  - (a) If you have previously taken one of the longer versions (e.g. School Personnel), you do NOT need to take the Volunteer version; simply upload your current certificate
  - (b) We believe you will NOT be required to retake the course once your certificate has expired
