<u>PLEASE COMPLY WITH AB506 REQUIREMENTS BEFORE APRIL 30</u> California Law AB506 requires youth serving organizations to take certain steps to protect children. ALL registered Scouters in GLAAC need to complete the State's Mandated Reporter training and complete a background check. Visit https://californiascouting.org/glaac/ for step-by-step instructions. Our February issue of Roundtable Matters included tips for taking the required training. Here are some tips for your LiveScan appointment.

- 1. You must take <u>GLAAC's form</u> with you
 - a. The form's Privacy Notice will explain how the data will be protected
- 2. According to the <u>State website</u>, some of the least expensive providers in the South Bay (no endorsement intened) are
 - a. Red Door Investments in Gardena
 - b. US Mail Plus in Torrance
 - c. 1 Airport Testing in Lawndale
 - d. UPS Store 5824 in Carson
- 3. CALL AHEAD and verify hours and fees. The website is NOT up to date.
- 4. Fees will include \$15 for the Federal check and a "rolling" fee, generally \$20-35. There may be an additional fee for using a credit card. Ask if you can save \$\$ by paying cash.
- 5. SAVE YOUR RECEIPT. If, for some reason, the State finds your prints unsatisfactory, return to the original vendor, who should "re-roll" at no additional charge
