SAFETY AFLOAT HAS BEEN UPDATED Scouting U has released an updated version of "Safety Afloat" training that is also mobile compatible. Safety Afloat is required for any BSA unit who will participate in boating activities. This online training, which must be renewed every two years, ensures that adult leaders are prepared to facilitate safe use of canoes, kayaks, rowboats, rafts, floating tubes, sailboats, motorboats (including waterskiing), and other small craft. To access the updated training, log onto my. Scouting.org and search the catalog in the BSA Learn Center for "Safety Afloat."
