<u>BUDDY SYSTEM UPDATES</u> Significant changes to the <u>Buddy System</u> in the Youth Protection and Adult Leadership Guide. Some updates include mixed gender buddy groups, sibling buddy groups, 3 year age gap for non-sleeping activities, parent or guardian serving as buddy, and parents tenting with scouts (beyond the cub scout exception).

<u>HUNTING NOW PROHIBITED</u> The BSA has published an updated Age <u>Appropriate Guidelines for Scouting Activities Table</u> which eliminates hunting as a scouting activity as well as removing all hunting exceptions and adding hunting as a prohibited activity in the <u>Guide to Safe Scouting</u>.

<u>CUB SCOUT PROGRAM CHANGES</u> Significant changes in the <u>Cub Program</u> are coming. More emphasis on personal safety, bobcat is earned each year (and is different for each rank as it builds to cover tenants of the Scout rank in BSA, focus on enabling multi year programs to just name a few). Lastly there is a change to focusing on transition to BSA for AOL scouts.

<u>PACIFICA MERIT BADGE DAY</u> The last Pacifica Merit Badge Day for this year is Saturday, October 12th at the Torrance Scout House. Registration will be opening soon. Cost will be \$25 for the day for up to four merit badge classes.

<u>PACIFICA HIKING MERIT BADGE</u> We will be offering hikes to help our Scouts earn the hiking merit badge. The first hike will be October 5th starting from Griffith Park, the second is November 2nd at Jones Peak and the third is January 4th on Gabrielino National Recreation Trail. These are also great training hikes for Philmont. Scouts and Scouters are welcome to hike with us even if you are not working on the merit badge. All hikes are free.
