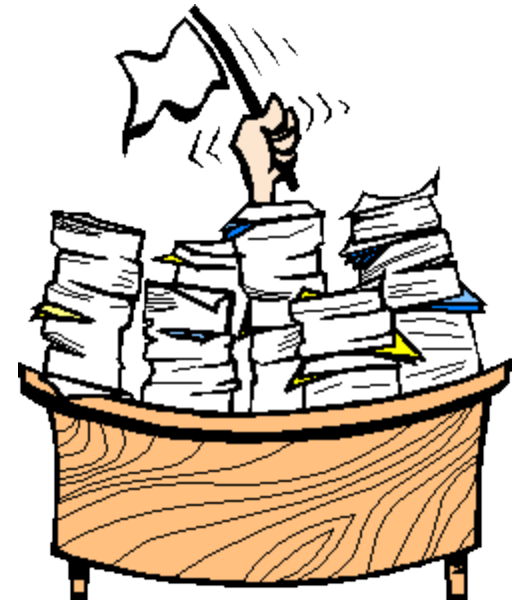

Why is Record Keeping So Hard?

- ❖ Records may be under different names (e.g. Joseph, Joe, Joey)
- ❖ Cub Scout records are separate from Boy Scout records
- ❖ Legacy systems were designed for single person access and relied on printed reports
- ❖ Successive systems weren't compatible with each other



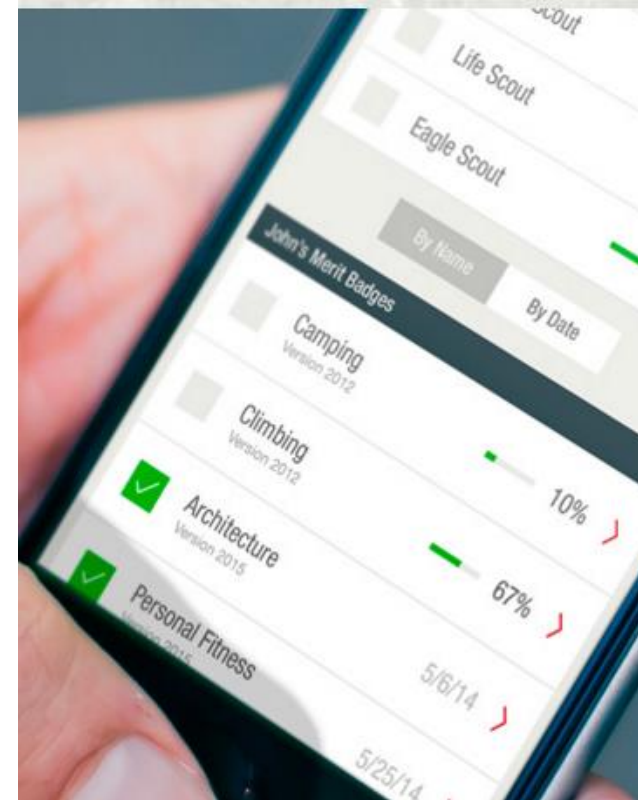
There Has to Be a Better Way!

- ❖ Volunteers should have more time doing what they signed up to do: ***helping youth***
- ❖ Making the process easier encourages units to enter their information regularly.



Introducing... Scoutbook!

- ❖ Owned by BSA, Scoutbook is positioned to be the one place where **all** units can track their activities
- ❖ Web-based – accessed from tools you already have
- ❖ Advancement can be signed off in real time
- ❖ Parents and Scouts can monitor progress towards rank
- ❖ Integrates with BSA records database



Features of Scoutbook

- ♣ Advancement tracking and reporting
- ♣ Rechartering tools
- ♣ Email and texting tools to stay in touch with parents
- ♣ Tools to organize activities and events
- ♣ Data accessible anywhere there is connectivity to the internet
